
BAUXILIARY Updates

AUXILIARY GRANTS

One of the major projects of the Auxiliary is to provide grant funding for hospital related programs. Last year, the Auxiliary approved \$104,000 in grant funding. Here's a report about one such grant.

iPads for Patient Education in TPP Surgical Specialties.

This \$3550 grant was for the purchase of 20 iPads with anti-microbial cases for the surgicare area. The goal was to educate patients about the surgical procedure, discharge and home care and thus reduce emergency room visits and opioid prescriptions. With the onset of the pandemic, these iPads provided additional and unanticipated



benefits! From March to early July, the iPads were shared with ENT, Weight Management, Neurology and General Surgery (TPP OFFICES) to allow physician to patient video conferences while respecting the stay at home order. The patient impact was on average 100 per week.

Due to the COVID 19 pandemic, the Auxiliary has postponed its grant making process until 2021. We will begin accepting applications for funding projects in January 2021 for FY 22 with funding available beginning July 1, 2021.
